- Unconscious biases are automatic judgments shaped by personal experiences and culture.

- Common biases in the workplace: affinity bias, gender bias, and confirmation bias.
- 
- Awareness is the first step towards managing and reducing bias.

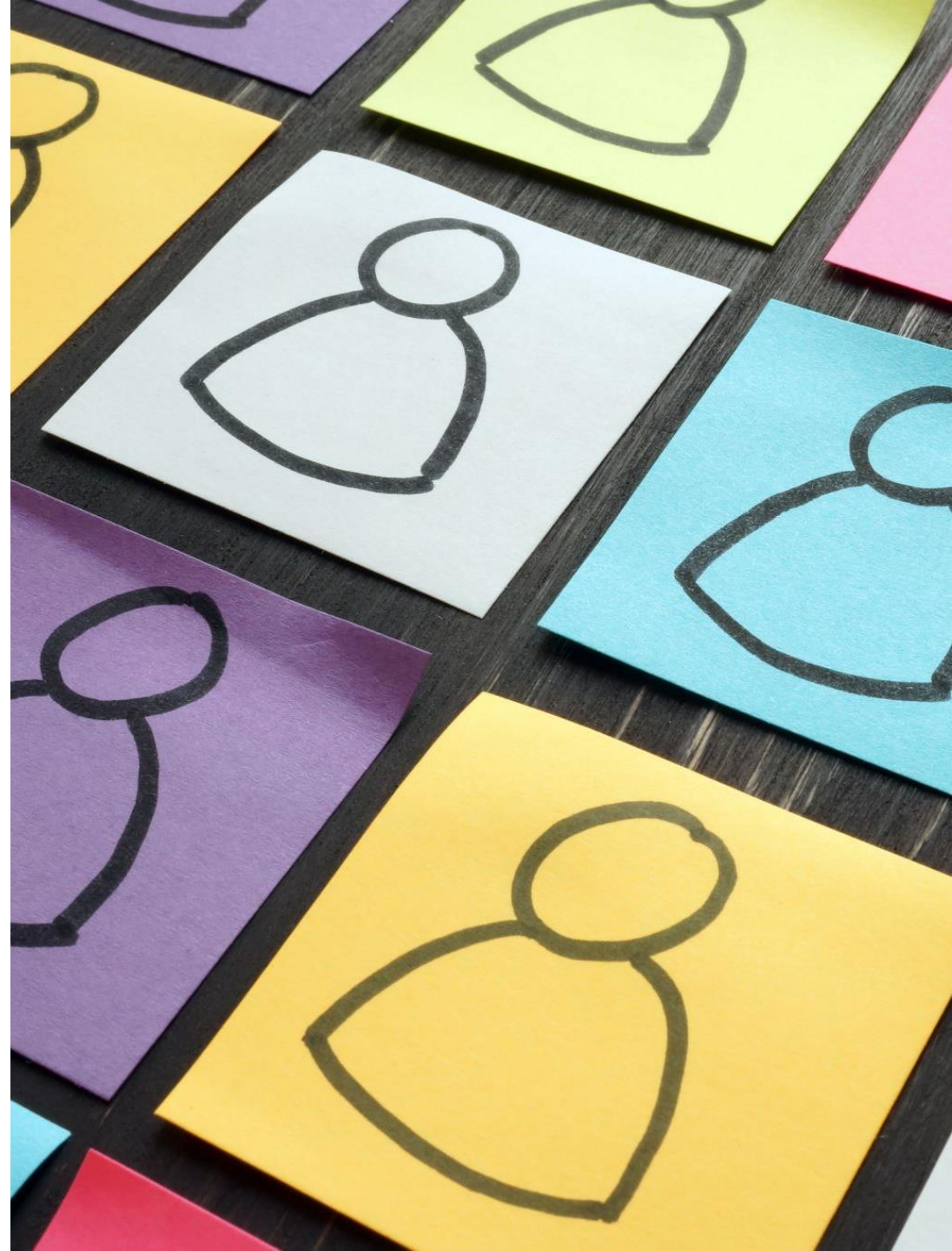
# COMMON TYPES OF UNCONSCIOUS BIAS

- - Affinity Bias: Preference for individuals who are similar to ourselves.
- - Gender Bias: Assumptions based on gender roles or stereotypes.
- - Confirmation Bias: Seeking information that confirms pre-existing beliefs.



# STRATEGIES TO MINIMISE BIAS

- - Self-Reflection: Regularly assess personal biases and how they influence decisions.
- - Structured Decision-Making: Use standard criteria in hiring, promotions, and evaluations.
- - Encourage Feedback: Create an open space for team feedback on inclusivity.

# ESTABLISHING TEAM NORMS

Set

- Set clear guidelines on inclusivity and mutual respect within the team.

Encourage

- Encourage inclusive language and behaviour in all team interactions.

Revisit

- Regularly revisit norms to ensure alignment with team values.



## CREATING SAFE SPACES FOR DISCUSSION

- Safe spaces allow team members to express ideas without fear of judgment.

- Leaders can facilitate regular check-ins and discussions.

- Encourage diverse viewpoints to promote innovation and team trust.

TEAM.

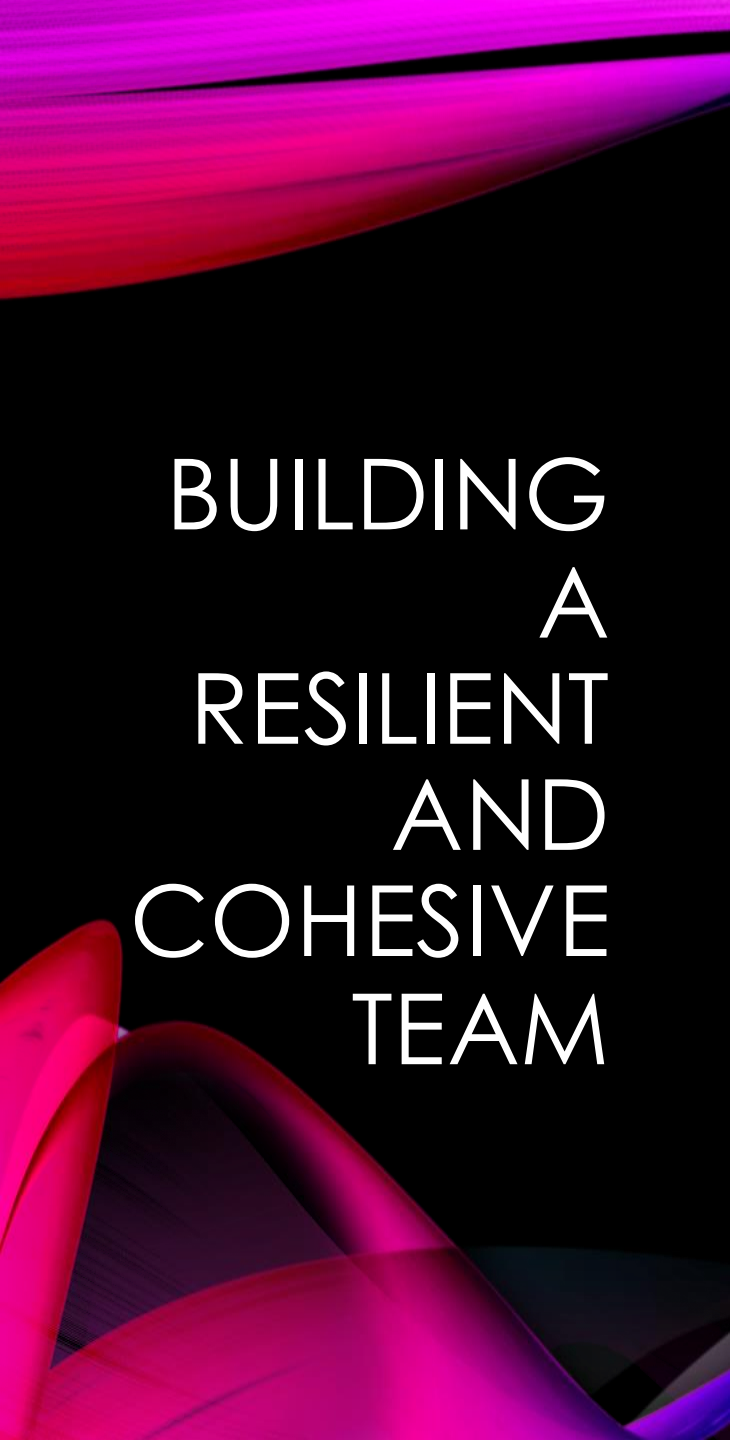


ACTIVITY:
